



What to Bring - Clothing & Accessories List

This is an outdoor adventure and the weather may change from sunny to cloudy to rainy, or from warm to cold so you will want to be prepared. The Voyageurs of the past were always prepared for any weather! Be smart - think about dressing in **LAYERS**. As it gets warmer, you can remove outer layers to stay cool, and when it gets colder, you can add layers to stay warm.

CLOTHING:

1. **Inside Layer:** Lighter, thinner clothing:
 - Lower Body: underwear, thin stretchy nylon sports pants (shorts if warm), wool socks, sports sandals/outdoor footwear*
 - Upper-Body: Quick-dry T-shirt
2. **Middle Layer:** Medium weight clothing:
 - Lower Body: Loose nylon/quick-dry camping pants
 - Upper-Body: Long-sleeved outdoor shirt
3. **Outer Layer:** Cold/Wet/Windy Weather clothing:
 - Lower Body: Breathable waterproof rainpants
 - Upper-Body: Warm sweater (wool or fleece)
Breathable waterproof windbreaker/rainjacket
Warm headgear (ie Wool Toque)
Gloves (for warmth and/or comfort)

NOTE: Your feet may get slightly wet and sandy. Please wear sports sandals or **USED/WORN** outdoor footwear such as old runners or walking shoes.

DAYPACK & SUPPLIES:

For carrying any extra clothing listed above **PLUS** the following items:

- Lunch/Snack
- 1 Litre Water
- Sun Hat
- Bandana
- Camera

IMPORTANT:

If you bring **ANY** Electronic equipment (ie. cell phone or digital camera) please put it in a **SEALED** Ziploc bag to protect it from splashes or the potential of dropping it in the water.

You will keep your daypack beside you so that everything is within easy reach.

Your Voyageur Adventure is going to be a lot of fun... please make sure you bring everything with you!
